INTERNATIONAL

• In political triumph, Trump acquitted of all impeachment charges. He was impeached by the House for conditioning \$391 million in military assistance to Ukraine and a crucial White House meeting with its president Volodymyr Zelensky.

NATIONAL

• Jagan launches website, Rythu Bharosa logo. The website acts as a platform to buy seeds through the Rythu Bharosa centres.

ECONOMY

- Kalyani Group, Bulgaria's Arsenal sign MoU to manufacture small arms. KSSL is the defence arm of Pune-based Kalyani group and Arsenal is a joint stock company from Bulgaria.
- Cognizant's D'Souza signs off, Bali to join as independent director. The other founder, Kumar Mahadeva, who served as the CEO for the first five years, retired from the board in 2003.
- Wipro wins multi-year strategic deal from automotive tech supplier Marelli.This partnership will help Marelli to standardize, simplify and further enhance their IT services at a global level and consolidate several current vendors across applications management services and workplace end-user services.
