Exam Pattern : Exam Pattern for Under Secretary written Exam (Mains) is as Follows:-

The written examination shall include two compulsory subject and two Optional Subject out of the 50 subjects.

Papers :-

- Paper I Current Affairs & Analytical Ability
- Paper II General English
- Paper III Optional Subject-I
- Paper IV Optional Subject-II

There will also be a Viva-Voce/Interview of 100 marks after written exam.
