Exam Pattern: Exam Pattern for Under Secretary written Exam (Mains) is as Follows:-

The written examination shall include two compulsory subject and two Optional Subject out of the 50 subjects.

Papers:-

Paper I Current Affairs & Analytical Ability
Paper II General English
Paper III Optional Subject-I
Paper IV Optional Subject-II

There will also be a Viva-Voce/Interview of 100 marks after written exam.
