- 1641 The Merchant Royal, carrying a treasure of over 100,000 pounds of gold (worth over £1 billion today), is lost at sea off Land's End.
- 1642 The first commencement exercises occur at Harvard College.
- 1821 Tripolitsa, Greece, is captured by Greek rebels during the Greek War of Independence.
- 1845 The Knickerbockers Baseball Club, the first baseball team to play under modern rules, is founded in New York.
- 1846 Astronomers Urbain Le Verrier, John Couch Adams, and Johann Gottfried Galle collaborate on the discovery of Neptune.
- 1868 Grito de Lares ("Lares Revolt") occurs in Puerto Rico against Spanish rule.
- 1889 Nintendo Koppai (Later Nintendo Company, Limited) is founded by Fusajiro Yamauchi to produce and market the playing card game Hanafuda.
- 1905 Norway and Sweden sign the Karlstad Treaty, peacefully dissolving the Union between the two countries.
- 1911 Pilot Earle Ovington makes the first official airmail delivery in America under the authority of the United States Post Office Department.
- 1913 Roland Garros of France becomes the first to fly in an airplane across the Mediterranean (from St. Raphael in France to Bizerte, Tunisia).
- 1932 The unification of Saudi Arabia is completed.
- 1938 The Czechoslovak army is mobilized in response to the Munich Agreement.
- 1962 The Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts opens in New York City.
- 1983 Saint Kitts and Nevis joins the United Nations.
- 1986 Houston Astros' Jim Deshaies sets a record, striking out the first eight batters he faces against the Los Angeles Dodgers.
- 2002 The first public version of the web browser Mozilla Firefox ("Phoenix 0.1") is released.
- 2019 The British travel company, Thomas Cook Group, declares bankruptcy, leaving employees without jobs and 600,000 customers stranded abroad. Hotels throughout the world are stuck with £338 million (U.S. \$415 million) in unpaid bills

- The Jammu & Kashmir administration headed by Lt-Gov Manoj Sinha on Wednesday issued orders of dismissal of six more employees, three each from Kashmir and Jammu divisions for having terror links and working as Over Ground Workers (OGW).
- India's first-ever mosque and the oldest in the sub-continent is all set to welcome back devotees and the general public after regaining its past glory and grandeur. The classic beauty and humble style of the "Cheraman Juma Masjid", dating back to 629 AD, was restored after a painstaking renovation and conservation process.

International Events-

- Nepal's newly-appointed Foreign Minister Narayan Khadka said on Wednesday that he will work towards maintaining friendly and balanced relations with India and China and forge national consensus with political parties on the matters of foreign relations. Khadka, 72, was sworn in as the Minister for Foreign Affairs on Wednesday.
- When Prime Minister Narendra Modi sits down on Friday with President Joe Biden and Prime Ministers Yoshihide Suga of Japan and Scott Morrison of Australia for their in-person summit -- the first with Biden -- they will face a world with a new set of complexities -- but also a higher level of intent by the US to involve itself in the region.
- A simple nasal spray of tiny antibodies produced by llamas could provide a new frontline treatment against the coronavirus that causes COVID-19, according to a study.
- The number of new COVID-19 cases continued to fall last week, with 3.6 million new cases reported globally, down from 4 million new infections the previous week, the World Health Organization said. Last week's drop marked the first substantial decline for more than two months, with falling COVID-19 cases in every world region.
- FBI Director Christopher Wray has warned that the Taliban takeover in Afghanistan could inspire a new wave of extremism in the US, The Hill reported.
