- 1875 Captain Matthew Webb became the first person to swim across the English Channel, traveling from Dover, England, to Calais, France, in 21 hours and 45 minutes
- 1894 Kitasato ShibasaburÅ⊡ discovered the infectious agent of the bubonic plague and published it in his findings in The Lancet
- 1916 The United States National Park Service was created
- 1945 The August Revolution ended as Emperor Bảo ĺạ¡ abdicated, ending the Nguyá» dynasty, the imperial dynasty of Vietnam.
- 1980 Zimbabwe joined the United Nations.
- 1981 Voyager 2 spacecraft made its closest approach to Saturn
- 1991 Belarus gained independence from the Soviet Union.
- 1991 Linus Torvalds announced the first version of Linux
- 2001 American singer Aaliyah and several members of her record died in an air crash as their overloaded aircraft crashes shortly after takeoff from Marsh Harbour Airport, Bahamas
- 2012 Voyager 1 spacecraft entered interstellar space, the first man-made object to do so
